			To our left are the C-213 gates, which are controlled by the C-104 facility.
			To the right, inside this building, the ISS Contractor performs surveillance and maintenance of the C-104 facility. In addition, this office space supports the ISS Badging and Site Access personnel.
			Note the propane tank to the east side of the building and the mailboxes south of the building.
			As we are exiting the parking lot, note the air monitoring station located to your left, across the street.
			[After turning right on Hobbs Road]:
			As we are heading north on Hobbs Road, you will see a gravel road to the right. This is the C-761 staging area and is assigned to the Deactivation and Remediation (or D&R) Contractor. It is used for staging incoming and exiting shipments.

			[When approaching DUF6]:
			The Depleted Uranium Hexafluoride (or DUF6) facilities are on the right.
			The ISS Contractor does not perform janitorial services for the DUF6 facilities but does perform grounds service including snow removal, parking lot, and vehicle bridge maintenance.

			The C-103 parking lot requires general maintenance and snow removal by the ISS Contractor.
			The ISS Contactor is also responsible for maintaining the electric vehicle charging stations. There are a total of three charging stations on-site like you see here.

On your right is the Security Complex, which consists of a Firing Range, Protective Force Building, Security Management Building, Training Facility, and Emergency Operations Center (or EOC). The ISS Contractor has responsibility for grounds service for the entire security complex including the C-221 Running Track located behind these facilities.
			The C-210 Security Management Building will be assigned to the ISS Contractor, which is responsible for surveillance and maintenance of this facility. Additionally, this building is assigned to the ISS Contractor for office space.
			The janitorial areas include: office space, conference rooms, restrooms, hallways, and break areas.
			The ISS Contractor is part of the EOC Cadre and is responsible for supporting emergency operations at the EOC as required. The EOC will be managed by the OSMS Contractor.

Driving Tour (Remain on the bus)	Turn bus around at the entrance to C-746-K Landfill.	C-611 facilities	Coming up on your left is Outfall 009. The D&R Contractor is responsible for monitoring and permit requirements for all outfalls on the Paducah site. The ISS Contractor is responsible for mowing all of the outfalls and adhering to the specific mowing requirements related to outfall areas.
			On the left is a roadway that leads to the rail crossing. The ISS Contractor is responsible for road maintenance and bridge inspection requirements.

			[After turning left on Water Works Road; and after crossing bridge]: As we head towards the Water Treatment Plant, we pass the C-746-K landfill on the left. The ISS Contractor is responsible for grounds service of this area. [At the turnaround point near C-611 Water Treatment Plant]: You will also see the Property Protection Area (or PPA) fence and gates that are the responsibility of the ISS Contractor. The PPA fence is the outermost controlled boundary of the Paducah site. The ISS Contractor is responsible for janitorial and grounds service at the C-611 Water Treatment Plant on your right, including mowing around the lagoons that are north of the facility.

			Since we can't take the bus any farther around the plant, I'll
			discuss the C-616-F Lagoon from here, which is at the north

			end of the Paducah Site. The ISS Contractor is responsible for mowing this area. Additionally, there are many sampling locations within this area, which include monitoring wells that have specific mowing requirements for sampling access.

The D&R Contractor has responsibility for this facility but the ISS Contractor will provide pest control and grounds service. [When in front of the C-743 Trailer Complex]: On the left is the C-743 Trailer area. All trailers but one are the responsibility of the D&R Contractor for surveillance and maintenance. The C-743-T14 trailer is assigned to the ISS Contractor, which is responsible for grounds service surrounding this trailer and other trailers in this area. As we proceed down this road, the C-720-G stores warehouse is on the left. This is managed by the D&R Contractor but the ISS Contractor is responsible for janitorial requirements.

			[After turning onto gravel road to the right; bus stops]:
			There are several facilities and trailers located within the C-730 area on the left. All are managed by the D&R Contractor but the ISS Contractor is responsible for janitorial requirements.
			As with all the occupied facilities, there are telecommunication lines running throughout them and are the responsibility of the ISS Contractor.

	This is C-101, which was previously a fully functioning cafeteria. Now it is only used for a training area, meetings, and general use. There are also food vendors that set up in this area on certain days.
	[Head back to bus; Stop at the C-100 main entrance and discuss upstairs cleaning]:
	There is a second floor that spans above us from east to west and contains offices, conference rooms, and bathrooms. The ISS Contractor is responsible for janitorial and pest control services.

			[While checking in at Post 15]:
			This is Post 15, which is the main entrance into the Limited Area. The Limited Area is a higher security area at the site, which requires a security clearance to enter or be escorted by cleared personnel.
			As a reminder, walking tours inside the Limited Area are required to stay with their security escort, so please stay with the group while we're walking and touring facilities.
			The ISS Contractor is responsible for maintaining Post 15 and the Limited Area fence as well as other fences on the site.

			One thing to note is that the fire suppression system is assigned to the D&R Contractor even though it is located in the ISS Contractor's assigned facilities, which may also be the case for other facility systems. The ISS Contractor must

			coordinate with the D&R Contractor for surveillance and maintenance of these types of systems. Looking east across 10 th Street, you can see the C-412 trailer complex, which is occupied by the D&R Contractor. The ISS Contractor is responsible for janitorial, pest control, and grounds service for these trailers.
14 Driving Tour (Remain on the bus)	Proceed south on 10 th Street	C-710	[While turning right on 10 th Street]: The C-710 building is on the left and is the responsibility of the D&R Contractor. The ISS Contractor is responsible for janitorial, pest control, and grounds service.
15 Driving Tour (Remain on the bus)	Turn left on Ohio Avenue Pause at Mac Portal for discussion	C-302 C-300	[After turning left onto Ohio Avenue; Pause at Mac Portal]: To your left you will see the C-302 Building, which is occupied by the D&R Contractor. The ISS Contractor is responsible for janitorial, pest control, and grounds service. The dome-shaped building on the left is the C-300 Building, which is the responsibility of the Operations and Site Mission Support (or OSMS) Contractor. This is the central control facility for the gaseous diffusion plant and includes the office of the plant shift superintendent. The ISS Contractor is responsible for grounds service for this facility.
16 Driving Tour (Remain on the bus)	Proceed on Ohio Avenue heading east Turn right on 13 th Street Turn left on Michigan Avenue Turn left on 16 th Street	C-310 C-333 C-746-Q Cooling Towers Switchyards C-734	[After passing the crosswalk]: On the left is the C-310 Purge and Product Building. The ISS Contractor is responsible for janitorial, pest control, and grounds service for this building.

[After turning right on 13 th Street]:
On the left is one of the four main process buildings on site, which is C-333. Deactivation work is currently being conducted by the D&R Contractor in this building. The ISS Contractor is responsible for janitorial, pest control, and grounds service in all process buildings. Janitorial services for process buildings typically include office spaces, break areas, and bathrooms.
[After turning left on Michigan Avenue]:
The DUF6 Contractor manages the cylinder yards outside the Limited Area fence on your right.
[While approaching C-746-Q]:
On your right is the C-746-Q Waste Storage Building managed by the D&R Contractor. The ISS Contractor is responsible for pest control and grounds service.
[After turning left on 16 th Street]:
There are four process buildings and each one has its own switchyard and cooling tower, all of which are inactive. The ISS Contractor is responsible for pest control and grounds service for these areas.
[While Bus stops at intersection of 16th Street and Tennessee Avenue]:
The ISS Contractor has operational responsibility for the C-734 Salt Storage Structure, which is the Tension Fabric Structure on your right.

As previously mentioned, the ISS Contractor is responsible for janitorial, pest control, and grounds service for all process buildings.

The ISS Contractor is responsible for janitorial, pest control, and grounds service for these facilities. [After turning right on Virginia Avenue, and while at the railroad tracks]: On the right, there are several burial grounds, which will be maintained by the ISS Contractor. Work in these areas must be coordinated with other site contractors for entry and work requirements. [After turning right on 8 th Street]: On your right is the C-720 Building, which is the responsibility of the D&R Contractor. However, the ISS Contractor is responsible for janitorial, pest control, and grounds service.

Although we did not discuss roads specifically, the ISS Contractor is responsible for maintaining all roads at the site. [After exiting the Limited Area, 10-minute restroom break]: We will now return to C 100 for a 10-minute break. [After turning left on Dyke Road]: As we proceed towards the C-755 Trailer Complex, you will see PPA fencing on the right. You will also see many gravel roads on both sides of the road. There are also four outfalls on this side of the plant site. [While stopped at the intersection of Dyke Road and McCAW Road]: On the right is the C-538 Substation, which is managed by the Tennessee Valley Authority (or TVA) and requires grounds service by the ISS Contractor. Additionally, on the left is the C-755-P gravel storage lot that is the responsibility of the ISS Contractor.

This is a Limited Area access point similar to Post 15.

			[When entering C-755 Complex]:
			This is the C-755 Trailer Complex, which is the responsibility of the ISS Contractor, with the exception of select trailers that are managed by the D&R Contractor. The ISS Contractor will use this area for equipment maintenance and storage, shower and break trailers, training, and office space. The ISS Contractor is responsible for maintaining the parking areas, fencing, sidewalks, and storm shelters.

	Make loop at landfill and return to Ogden Landing Road Turn left onto Ogden Landing		The ISS Contractor is responsible for janitorial, pest control, and grounds service for the landfill and facilities. These facilities contain office spaces, break areas, and restrooms.
	Road		[After passing C-746-U3 on the right]:
	Turn right onto Metropolis Lake Road		
	Turn right onto Woodville Road		You will see the sedimentation basin on the right that is part of the landfill operations. The basin and the leachate treatment system discharge to Outfalls. The ISS Contractor
	Turn left onto Hobbs Road		is responsible for mowing at the landfill areas.
			You will notice monitoring wells throughout this area that require periodic mowing to support sampling activities. The TVA is north of the landfill and requires mowing to support environmental sampling and many gravel roads which require maintenance.

	[After exiting the landfill security gate]:
	This concludes the site tour. We will now head back to the Convention Center.
