IA Scope of Work
Between
U.S. Environmental Protection Agency
And
U.S. Department of Energy

1.0 PURPOSE

The purpose of the Interagency Agreement (IA) between the U.S. Department of Energy (DOE) and the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) is to obtain EPA's continued support of the Decommissioning and/or Long Term Stewardship Supplemental Environmental Impact Statement (SEIS) at the West Valley Demonstration Project (WVDP) and the Western New York Nuclear Service Center (WNYNSC) as a cooperating agency.

2.0 BACKGROUND

On February 21, 2018, the DOE and the New York State Energy Research and Development Authority (NYSERDA) announced their intent to jointly prepare a Supplemental Environmental Impact Statement (SEIS) for Decommissioning and/or Long-Term Stewardship at the West Valley Demonstration Project and Western New York Nuclear Service Center (DOE/EIS-0226-S1), and to conduct a public scoping process to examine the potential environmental impacts of the proposed action to decommission and/or maintain long-term stewardship at the WVDP and WNYNSC. This notice identified the EPA (among other Federal and State agencies) as a cooperating agency under the National Environmental Policy Act (NEPA). A preliminary draft of this document is scheduled to be issued for a multi-agency review beginning in late 2021. A thorough review of the SEIS and its supporting documents by the agencies will allow early input on the analyses of the environmental impacts associated with the decommissioning alternatives to be analyzed.

3.0 SCOPE OF WORK

- 3.1 EPA is tasked to review and comment on the preliminary draft SEIS (and supporting documents) that is estimated to be issued in late 2021 for multi-agency review. This IA shall include, but is not limited to, EPA review of the SEIS with respect to its environmental and public health laws [e.g., the Resource Conservation and Recovery Act (RCRA)] and those other such aspects and areas for which EPA has other specific types of expertise and/or state delegated programs.
- 3.2 EPA will participate in periodic teleconferences, meetings, and workshops during this multiagency review period and during any comment resolution period following this initial review.
- 3.3 EPA will provide a consolidated set of written comments to DOE within 90 days of being provided the Draft SEIS.
- 3.4 EPA will review and respond in writing or otherwise, as appropriate, to DOE responses with regard to the EPA comments on the preliminary draft SEIS.
- 3.5 EPA will review and provide written comments on any subsequent revisions to the preliminary draft SEIS during the period covered in this IA.
- 3.6 DOE and EPA will work together to develop an overall schedule for accomplishing additional activities under this IA.
- 3.5 EPA will provide site-specific expertise and advice for regulatory issues in their purview during the period covered in the IA.

4.0 LEVEL OF EFFORT

Based on the information provided by DOE regarding the scope of the review, the EPA estimates the project work is about 1.0 FTE (about \$100,000 per year)

5.0 COST

The total estimated cost for accomplishing this work is \$100,000 per year. EPA is not authorized to expend or commit funds in excess of the amount obligated. If it is anticipated that the funds provided by this IA will be insufficient to complete the work required, EPA shall notify the DOE Contracting Officer in writing of the predicted short fall and shall not proceed until additional funds are added by modification to the IA.

6.0 DURATION OF THE AGREEMENT-

This agreement extends from date of signature of the IA by both parties until September 30, 2025. Should it be necessary to complete and perform additional scope as identified in 3.0 above, this IA may be extended beyond September 30, 2025. Extensions shall be in one-year increments for a maximum of two years subject to availability of funds and shall require the approval of both parties.

7.0 DELIVERABLES-

EPA review (and comment) on the preliminary draft SEIS and supporting documents as well as any subsequent revisions.

8.0 TERMINATION -

DOE may terminate this agreement upon 60 day written notice of such termination addressed to the performing agency. In the event of such termination, EPA shall be reimbursed, to the extent permitted by DOE regulations, for obligations actually incurred prior to the effective date of the termination. For obligations made prior to the termination and extending beyond the effective date of termination, reimbursement shall be made only to the date upon which the Agreement would have expired if not terminated under this paragraph.
